





### **Kindergarten Resource Fairs**

Focusing on a smooth transition to kindergarten, shift\_ed hosts annual Kindergarten Resource Fairs for students and families making the leap from Pre-K to kindergarten or directly from family/friend/neighbor care to kindergarten. A quality transition to kindergarten brings lifelong benefits to children and sets the tone for their educational experience for many years to come. #### HELPS 1:1

Helping Early Literacy with Practice Strategies (HELPS), developed and owned by Helping Education, is an evidence-based program designed to improve literacy outcomes by strengthening a student's oral reading fluency— a foundational element of reading proficiency. This key factor plays a critical role in increasing the percentage of students who meet proficiency standards as "college- and career-ready" by the end of third grade.

#### your\_path Career Accelerator

shift\_ed's your\_path career accelerator platform brings even more career exposure opportunities to students. This platform takes the YouScience Aptitude Assessment further by allowing students to virtually engage with industry professionals in each of the 16 career clusters across 5 career pathways with a focus on local industries with workforce needs.

#### World of Work (WoW)

With the mission of exposing the most students to the most career opportunities, shift\_ed partners with Guilford County School's CTE Department to organize the World of Work event, bringing together a variety of industries in a trade-show-like atmosphere. Students build upon their YouScience Assessment to match aptitudes with industries in which their talents are naturally aligned.





#### **Mobile Innovation Lab**

By way of an upfitted bus complete with real-world STEAM equipment, shift ed provides an innovative approach to collaborative, hands-on, minds-on learning aligned with district classroom curriculum. Learning through the mobile innovation labs allows students to experience unique STEAM learning opportunities like laser cutters, 3D printers, CNC Routers, and more. STEAM-related jobs are the jobs of the future.



## **GRADUATING HIGHLY PREPARED STUDENT** LEADERS THAT ARE

#### **Sponsors for Educational Opportunity (SEO) Scholars**

**COLLEGE- OR CAREER-READY.** 

SEO Scholars is a free, eight-year college access program (academic remediation, high-school completion, access to college) that offers mentoring and support to get under-served high school students to and through college. Scholars enrolled in the program receive the equivalent of 2.5 years of additional English and 1.5 years of additional math instruction in an effort to close the academic and opportunity gaps, allowing students to graduate high school with the skills necessary to tackle college with confidence.

#### SAT/ACT Prep Classes

While some colleges and universities are moving away from mandatory SAT/ACT scores being submitted with applications, many scholarships still require or encourage students to submit their scores to be considered for meaningful tuition assistance. shift\_ed is providing FREE SAT and ACT courses open to students



at all 28 district high schools in both the spring and fall semesters.

#### **FAFSA Preparation Workshop**

Understanding and accessing free federal dollars for college tuition begins with the completion of the FAFSA or Free Application for Federal Student Aid. For many parents, students and guardians this application can be intimidating, confusing, and stressful. Our staff work with high schools across the district to host free FAFSA workshops where trained staff and volunteers can assist families as they fill out the FAFSA in real-time from their schools' computer lab.

#### **CACRAO College Fair**

shift\_ed, in collaboration with GCS Counseling and College Foundation of North Carolina (CFNC), aims to familiarize students with various colleges and universities through the CACRAO College Fair. This event provides a platform for numerous institutions to showcase their

unique offerings. Additionally, families can attend financial aid sessions, gaining valuable insights into the financial aspects of higher education.

#### **HBCU College Fair**

To further our goal of exposing students to colleges and universities, shift ed hosts an Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) College Fair in partnership with GCS Counseling, CFNC, and Mt.

Zion Baptist Church. HBCUs from within North Carolina and beyond gather to highlight their unique opportunities.

#### **College Readiness** Programming

Scholars attend a series of workshops before the beginning of their first year of college. Topics include adjustment to college life, homesickness, health issues, time management, course selection, relationship-building with professors and effective study strategies.

#### 1:1 Financial Aid Counseling

Under the guidance of our dedicated college admissions team, shift\_ed helps students connect with campuses, communicate with admissions officers and receive personalized assistance. They also get

#### shift\_ed Tuition Awards

Tuition Awards levels the academic playing field and addresses financial barriers through an updated scholarship model that will focus 75% of funding paid to families with household incomes of \$75.000 and less. A stronger pipeline helps our community recruit more industries by supplying diverse talent for the workforce.

#### **Navigating Campus and Community Resources**

Data shows, leveraging on-campus resources drastically increases graduation, persistence and retention rates. Because of this, shift\_ed has created summer programming highlighting campus resources for shift\_ed scholars to take advantage of. These resources include mental

tutoring centers, recreational services, child services, health services, etc. In partnership with several local colleges and universities, shift\_ed has agreements with financial aid departments to provide federal work-study positions for undergraduate students. shift ed has work-study jobs available in literacy tutoring, mathematics tutoring and middle school CTE programming.


#### **Career Exploration** and Networking

shift\_ed Scholars work with the shift\_ed team to explore multiple career paths based on personal preferences and academic aptitude. The process is ongoing, dynamic, and fully utilizes the wealth of resources from shift ed's network of current Scholars, alumni and friends.

#### shift\_ed Alumni Association

shift ed alumni have access to career management and skill-building training platforms, webinars, in-person events, executive resume writing and professional headshots. shift\_ed provides coaching, cultural experiences, board service, job opportunities, access to industry experts, support for entrepreneurs and more.





#### **Cisco Networking Academy**

Designed to prepare students for Cisco Certification and other industry-recognized certification exams, shift ed provides an eight-week course designed to prepare students for the Manpower Certification Exam. These certifications are highly valued by employers globally, as they demonstrate exceptional skills relevant to many industries including health care, manufacturing, retail, financial, education and more. If students complete the course, shift ed provides a free voucher to sit for the exam.
